DAY 1

TUESDAY, APRIL 6

Arrival in Paris by 12:00pm local time, transfer to hotel, Cocktail reception & welcome dinner at Domaine de Beaulieu.



DAY 2

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 7

Belgium: A day exploring Canadian First World War sites, including Essex Farm (where Lt. Col John McCrae wrote “In Flanders Fields”), Passchendaele, The Brooding Soldier Memorial at Vancouver Corner, and others. This evening we will participate in the emotional “Last Post” ceremony at the Menin Gate in Ypres.



DAY 3

THURSDAY, APRIL 8

A day exploring The Somme, including the intimate and moving Newfoundland Memorial at Beaumont Hamel, with other visits including Hawthorn Crater, Thiepval (the majestic British Memorial to the Missing of the Somme), and the Canadian memorial at Courcellette.

FRIDAY, APRIL 9

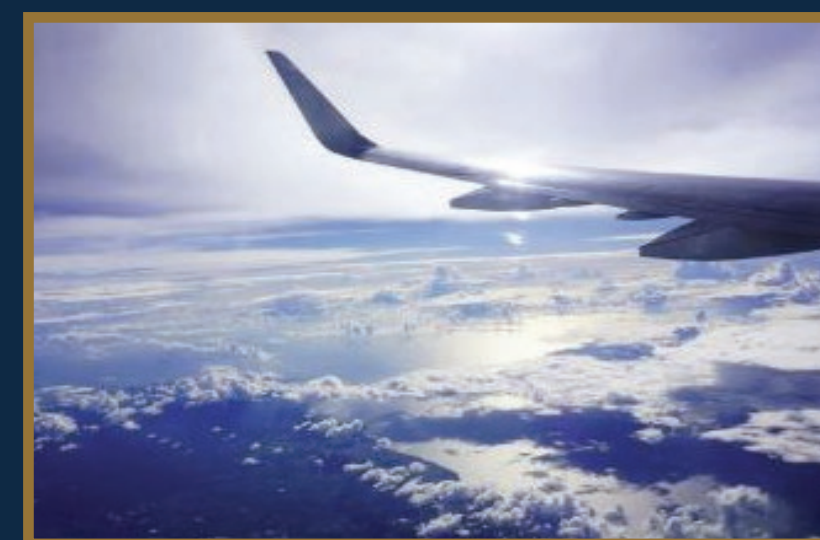
110th Anniversary of the Battle of Vimy Ridge.
